Village of Mamaroneck, Village Engineer in charge of DPW

The Village of Mamaroneck, NY, is a Village of approximately 19,000 residents, located on the Long Island Sound in Westchester County, NY. The Village operates under the Council-Manager form of government, in which the Village Manager supervises the day-to-day operations of the Village. The Village is seeking to hire a Village Engineer through the regulated NY State and Westchester County Civil Service Process who will be assigned charge of the Department of Public Works, to manage and supervise the operations of the Department, including the coordination and planning of Capital projects with the Village Manager's Office and other departments.

To be considered for this position, candidate must presently be eligible through the Civil Service Process (be on the list) or hold the title of Village Engineer in the County of Westchester, and be a licensed Professional Engineer in the State of New York. Required knowledge and skills includes thorough knowledge of engineering principles, budget management and compliance with municipal bidding requirements, civil capital projects, fleet management, building construction, public works facilities, and other similar facilities and projects. Personal attributes must include the ability to obtain the cooperation and support of others, perform studies and reports; plan, supervise and manage the work of the department and contractors, honesty, dependability, sound judgment, and physical condition commensurate with the duties of the position.
