

Claflin Ave, Jefferson Ave, and Seney Ave Construction and Traffic Advisory



Beginning Monday, March 11, Green Mountain Pipeline Services, working on behalf of the Village of Mamaroneck, will begin sewer repair work at the following locations:



- Claflin Avenue (between Rushmore Avenue and Sylvan Avenue),
- Jefferson Avenue (from Wood Street to the Cul-De-Sac), and
- Seney Avenue (between Walton Avenue and Claflin Avenue)



This work will take place from 7:00am to 5:00pm within a 300 linear foot sequential active work zone having only one lane open with alternating traffic at each of these locations.

Flagmen will be on-site to direct traffic in this area during work hours. This active work zone will require "No Parking" at any time. Construction signs and devices will be posted to notify residents and drivers. The rest of these streets will remain normal with two-way traffic and parking in accordance with posted signs.

We expect this construction and temporary construction traffic pattern to be in place for approximately one (1) week at each location. Temporary No Parking Signs and Boards will be installed a minimum of 48 hours in advance of the work at each location so residents will be notified of the exact start date at each location.

Motorists and residents around these streets and surrounding areas should expect traffic as well as construction and detour signs while this work is performed. Driving and parking in this area may be difficult. Motorists are encouraged to use alternative routes. We apologize for this inconvenience. As always, please slow down and drive responsibly.
